**NOTICE OF FORMAL COMPLAINT AND  
ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PRELIMINARY REPORT**

On September 2, 2020, Missouri Landowners Alliance, Eastern Missouri Landowners Alliance d/b/a Show Me Concerned Landowners, and John G. Hobbs (Complainants) filed the attached complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Grain Belt Express, LLC, and Invenergy Transmission, LLC (Respondents). Under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(8), Respondents have thirty days from the date of this notice to satisfy or answer the complaint. A copy of the answer or response shall also be served upon complainants at the address provided in the complaint. Provisions governing procedures before the Commission are found in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240 Chapter 2. In particular, the procedures relating to discovery are found at Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090.

In accordance with the Commission's procedural rules, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a preliminary report stating when it anticipates being able to file a full report detailing its findings and recommendations.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send, by certified mail, a copy of this notice and order, and a copy of the complaint to the Respondents, Grain Belt Express, LLC and Invenergy Transmission, LLC.
2. Grain Belt Express, LLC, and Invenergy Transmission, LLC shall file their answer or response to the complaint no later than October 3, 2020.
3. The Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a preliminary report no later than October 18, 2020, stating when it anticipates being able to file a full report detailing its findings and recommendations concerning the complaint.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
