My name is Kevin Thompson, and I am 7 sitting in for the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to 8 preside over this matter, Lewis Mills. When last seen, he 9 was in agenda getting some very difficult questions from 10 the Commissioners. FISCHER: I'm hopeful, yes. 23 JUDGE THOMPSON: Mr. Dottheim, how about 24 you? 25 MR. DOTTHEIM: The Staff is hopeful, too,

21	we're hopeful this contingency won't really arise.
