2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome everyone to this
3 conference in Case No. EO-2006-0240. We're here today to discuss
4 the filings that AmerenUE has filed regarding their public and
5 confidential versions of their Integrated Resource Plan.

6 We'll begin today by taking entries of appearance
7 beginning with Union Electric.

8 MR. LOWERY: Thank you, your Honor. My name is
9 James B. Lowery, Smith, Lewis, LLP, 111 South Ninth Street, PO Box
10 918, Columbia, Missouri 65205 and I represent AmerenUE.

11 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you.

2 MS. WOODS: Shelley A. Woods, assistant attorney
3 general, Post Office Box 899, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102,
4 appearing on behalf of the Missouri Department of Natural
5 Resources.

6 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. The other parties
7 today are Noranda Aluminum, and I do not see counsel here for
8 them, and also Missouri Energy Group. I had some conversation
9 with Lisa Langeneckert's office yesterday and she indicated she
10 might be calling in today, but she has not called in. If she
11 calls in later, we'll go ahead and add her to the line. If she
12 calls in after we're off the record, somebody needs to push the
13 button on the phone up here. There's a speakerphone on the bench.

14 All right. I believe that's all the parties. As I
15 indicated, the purpose of this conference was to facilitate
16 discussion amongst the parties regarding the adequacy of the
17 redacted version of Ameren's IRP that was filed a week ago.
18 Essentially I'm just going to leave you to your conversations once
19 we get off the record. If there's anything that needs to be
20 brought to the Commission's attention, just file an appropriate
21 motion and the Commission will deal with that. Hopefully you can
22 work out any disagreements you might have informally today.

23 Is there anything that anyone wants to bring up
24 while we're on the record?

25 MR. LOWERY: I don't believe from the company's

1 perspective, at least at this point, I can think of anything that
2 needs to be brought up on the record.

3 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Well, thank you all very
4 much then. With that, the on-the-record portion of this
5 conference is adjourned and I'll leave you to your discussions.
