PROCEEDINGS 1 2 JUDGE PRIDGIN: On the record, please. All right. Good morning. We're on the record. This 3 4 is the prehearing conference in Case No. 5 EO-2007-0485, in the matter of the Application of 6 Interstate Power and Light Company, formerly known 7 as, IES Utilities, Incorporated and ITC Midwest LLC, 8 for Approval to Transfer Certificate of Convenience 9 and Necessity and Transmission Line Facilities in Clark County, Missouri, and Motion for Expedited 10 11 Treatment. 12 I am Ron Pridgin. I'm the regulatory law judge assigned to preside over this prehearing 13 14 conference being held on August 6th, 2007, in the Governor Office Building in Jefferson City, Missouri, 15 16 and we also have some counsel participating by 17 telephone. The time is about 10:07 a.m. I'd like 18 to get verbal entries of appearance from counsel, 19 20 beginning with the General Counsel's office, please. 21 MR. WILLIAMS: Nathan Williams, 22 P.O. 1 And could the folks on the phone verify, are you able to hear Mr. Williams okay? 2 MR. NORRIS: We were not, actually. 3 4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. Let me pull 5 the phone up a little bit better and hopefully --6 it was simply his entry of appearance, and once 7 this portion is over, I can move the phone over 8 to where you folks are able to talk a little 9 clearer. 10 For the Office of the Public Counsel, 11 please. 12 MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of 13 the Public Counsel and the public, my name is Lewis Mills. My address is Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson 14 15 City, Missouri 65102. 16 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Mills, thank you. 17 On behalf of Interstate Power and Light Company, 18 please. MR. NORRIS: Verle W. Norris, 300 West 19 20 Marion, P.O. Box 256, Corydon, Iowa 50060. 21 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Norris, thank you. 22 On behalf of ITC Midwest, LLC, please. 23 MR. STEINER: Roger W. Steiner, 24 Sonnenschein, Nath & Rosenthal, 4520 Main Street, Suite 1100, Kansas City, Missouri 64111. 25

JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Steiner, thank you. 1 On behalf of AmerenUE, please. 2 MS. TATRO: Subject to your granting our 3 4 motion pro hac vice to be formally filed later, Wendy 5 Tatro on behalf of AmerenUE, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, 6 St. Louis, Missouri 63166. 7 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Tatro, thank you. I don't believe we have any other counsel or any other 8 9 parties. Is there anyone else who wishes to enter an 10 appearance? 11 (NO RESPONSE.) 12 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Hearing 13 none -- and Ms. Tatro, thank you for bringing that 14 up. If I could remind you and Mr. Norris, 15 if you're not members of the Missouri Bar, to 16 consult the Supreme Court of Missouri rules on the 17 practice before a Missouri court or an 18 administrative tribunal without a Missouri law 19 20 license, and I believe Rule 6 spells out the fees 21 and Rule 9 spells out the process you get through, 22 and also the Commission has its own rules. 23 Chapter 2 would be our rules on practice 24 and procedure. 25 But if you'll please consult those and

comply with those in order to continue appearing in
this case.

I don't think -- other than a motion for 3 4 expedited treatment, I don't know if there are any 5 other motions pending or anything else counsel needs 6 to bring to my attention or get a ruling on. 7 MR. STEINER: I don't believe so, not 8 that I'm aware of. 9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. Hearing nothing from counsel, is there anything else counsel requires 10 from me before we go off the record? 11 12 (NO RESPONSE.) 13 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Hearing 14 nothing, again, I'll remind the parties this port should be open until noon. If you need to speak any 15 16 time after that, you'll need to make other 17 arrangements. 18 You should have access to this hearing room for whatever reason you might need it until five 19 o'clock, and I will be up on the ninth floor. If 20 21 local parties need to consult me or if anybody needs 22 to call me, I should be in the office until about 23 five o'clock. 24 If there's nothing further, all right,
