PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company (Empire or Applicant), and also on behalf of Kansas City Power & Light Company; Aquila, Inc.; the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission; the Office of the Public Counsel; Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP); and, Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

- 1. Empire noted in its Application that the SPP Regional Transmission Organization (RTO) is scheduled to begin its Energy Imbalance Service (EIS) market on May 1, 2006. The EIS market is designed to create a real-time energy spot market based on locational pricing.

 Based upon a desire to complete these proceedings in time for Empire to have the opportunity to fully participate in the EIS market, Empire's Application requested that the Commission address this matter prior to May 1, 2006.
- 2. The parties have discussed this timing issue and have agreed that setting a procedural schedule would further the goal of presenting this case to the Commission for a timely decision. The procedural schedule agreed to by the parties calls for both negotiations with a goal toward possible settlement and the scheduling of litigation landmarks, in case the parties are unable to settle the case.
 - 3. With these goals in mind, the parties propose the following procedural schedule:

IIB. IF STIPULATION CANNOT BE REACHED (Status Report filed on February 6, 2006, indicating that agreement cannot be reached).
