On December 6, 2004, Aquila, Inc., asked for authority to sell and lease back three natural gas-fired combustion turbines. The Commission scheduled a hearing on Aquila's application for July 13 and 14.

On June 23, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and Hearing and Request for Expedited Treatment. OPC stated that the Circuit Court of Cass County enjoined Aquila from building the generating station. Further, OPC stated that Aquila appealed the injunction, and that the Court of Appeals recently affirmed the circuit court.

In light of the Court of Appeals' opinion, OPC states that Aquila's application is moot, and asks that the Commission suspend the hearing. Also, OPC asks for expedited treatment, with a Commission ruling on the motion no later than July 8.

The Commission finds OPC's request for expedited treatment reasonable. The Commission will order the parties to respond to OPC's motion no later than June 29.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the parties shall respond to the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and Hearing and Request for Expedited Treatment no later than June 29, 2005.
