ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 2, 2005, Aquila, Inc., asked for Commission approval of its experimental regulatory plan, and a certificate of convenience and necessity to build generation plant known as latan Unit 2. The Commission set an intervention deadline of April 1, and granted all timely intervention requests.

On April 6, Aquila filed a motion in which it requested the Commission set a prehearing conference. On April 13, the Commission granted the motion, and set a prehearing conference for April 21.

The parties have informed the Commission that they have been meeting regularly, and will continue to meet to discuss settlement. Because the parties are negotiating, the parties ask that the Commission cancel the prehearing conference, and suspend the requirement that the parties file a proposed procedural schedule. The Commission will grant their request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the prehearing conference is canceled.
- 2. That the parties' requirement to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than April 28, 2005 is suspended.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 21, 2005.
