ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is denying the application for rehearing ("motion") filed by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's ("GMO"). GMO filed the motion on September 8, 2011. The Commission received no response to the motion within the time allowed by regulation.¹ Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." But, in the motion, GMO only restates arguments that the Commission rejected in the *Report and Order*. The restated arguments are not a sufficient reason for a rehearing. Therefore, the Commission will deny the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Application for Rehearing of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company* is denied.
