## ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 20, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO), the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the industrial intervenors, Praxair, Inc., and Sedalia Industrial Energy Users Association, jointly filed a proposed procedural schedule. The parties explain that the delay in commencement of scheduled activities is occasioned by the ongoing Kansas City Power & Light Company and GMO rate cases, ER-2010-0355 and ER-2010-0356 respectively, in which they are actively involved. The Commission has considered the proposed schedule and will adopt it with an addition.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule is adopted. The schedule is as follows:
