**ORDER AND NOTICE**

On August 29, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application requesting that the Commission: A) approve its decommissioning cost estimate; B) approve decommissioning funding at the current level; and C) find that the decommissioning costs are included in its current cost of service and are properly reflected in current rates for ratemaking purposes.

Proper parties shall be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Data Center of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to all parties in Case No. EO-2006-0094, KCPL's previous decommissioning cost level case. The Information Office of the Commission shall send notice to the members of the General Assembly who represent counties within KCPL's service area in Missouri, and to the newspapers, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current *Official Manual of the State of Missouri*, that serve the counties within KCPL's service area in Missouri.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall give notice as set forth herein.

2. The Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall give notice as set forth herein.
