Second¹ Order Extending Time For Staff's Recommendation

The Missouri Public Service Commission is extending the time for the Commission's staff ("Staff") to file its recommendation. The recommendation was due on March 6, 2009. On March 9, 2009, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time ("motion"). The motion states that Staff has completed its site visit and asks for more time to thoroughly review the facts. A thorough review of the facts will enhance the quality of Staff's recommendation. Also, the requested extension is until March 11, 2009, which will not unduly delay these proceedings because it is five days from the current due date and only two days from the date of this order. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. The Commission's staff shall file its recommendation no later than March 11, 2009.
