ORDER Extending Time For Staff's Recommendation

The Missouri Public Service Commission is extending the time for the Commission's staff ("Staff") to file its recommendation.

On January 22, 2009, the Commission ordered Staff to file its recommendation as to the application of Jerry West and Sharon West ("the Wests"). The Wests seek to change a supplier of electricity to their property. The Commission ordered Staff's recommendation filed no later than February 20, 2009. On February 20, 2009, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time ("the motion"). The motion states that Staff has not inspected the property, which is necessary to its recommendation.

Our regulations ordinarily allow ten days for parties to respond to a motion,¹ but they also provide that we may shorten that time, or any time set by Commission order.² Staff asks for an extension until March 6, 2009, which is 14 days. Fourteen days will not unduly delay these proceedings, so the Commission will grant the extension.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
