## ORDER ESTABLISHING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES

On May 29, 2009, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") and the White River Valley Electric Cooperative ("White River") filed a joint application requesting that the Commission approve an addendum to their territorial agreement. The addendum would allow White River to provide electric service to a single lot that is currently situated in Empire's service territory. No interested person or entity sought intervention, and to date, no party has requested a hearing.

On June 29, the Commission's Staff filed its recommendation that the Commission approve the proposed addendum. The Commission shall set a deadline for responses.

Additionally, the Commission observes that in its June 1 order directing notice and setting various deadlines, the Commission imposed a requirement for the filing of a procedural schedule no later than July 6. That requirement was contingent on there being a request for an evidentiary hearing, and that requirement shall be canceled if no hearing is requested within the deadline set for responses in this order.

1. Any party wishing to file a response to the recommendation filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission on June 29, 2009, shall file its response no later than 8:00 a.m. on July 6, 2009.

2. Any party wishing to request an evidentiary hearing shall file its request no later than 8:00 a.m. on July 6, 2009.

3. In the event no party requests an evidentiary hearing, the requirement for filing a procedural schedule on July 6, 2009 shall be canceled.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
