ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DATE, AND DIRECTING DATA CENTER TO ADD PARTIES TO THE SERVICE LIST

On July 1, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (KCP&L-GMO) filed a tariff to adjust the rate the company recovers under the fuel adjustment clause approved by the Commission in the company's rate case, ER-2007-0004. The tariff would increase charges related to the fuel adjustment clause by approximately \$20 million for the areas formerly served by Aquila Networks – L&P and Aquila Networks – MPS. KCP&L-GMO indicates the requested rate increase will increase a typical residential customer's bill by approximately \$1 per month for the Aquila Networks -- L&P territory and approximately \$0.35 for the Aquila Networks – MPS territory. The Commission will give notice of the filing of this tariff to the public and will set a date for the filing of intervention requests.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established KCP&L-GMO's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. The Commission therefore acknowledges that the parties to ER-2007-0004 are parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

 The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to the County Commission for each of the counties in KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area.

2. The Commission's Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area.

3. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to Case No. ER-2007-0004 to the service list for this case.

4. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than July 22, 2009. Such application shall be filed with:
