This case began on August 4, 2009, when Harold and Debbie Meyer filed an application to change their electric service provider from the City of Marceline, Missouri, to Macon Electric Cooperative. Following pleadings from the City and the Staff of the Commission, a prehearing conference was held on January 12, 2010. The Applicants did not appear. A second conference was scheduled but canceled at the request of the City's counsel for medical reasons. On June 25, 2010, the City filed a status report advising the Commission that counsel was again able to participate in a prehearing and providing a list of suggested dates.

On August 4, 2010, Staff filed a status report. Staff relates that it has attempted several times, without success, to contact the Applicants by telephone, and also sent the Applicants a letter on July 21, 2010, to which it has not received a response.

The Commission would like to move this case forward toward a resolution. To that end, the Commission will direct the Applicants to respond in writing, advising whether they wish to pursue their application and, if so, providing dates on which they would be available to participate in a prehearing conference, either in person or by telephone. The Applicants shall state on which dates they are available from the following dates: August 30, 31; September 2, 3, 21, 22, 23, 27 28, 29 and 30.

If the Applicants fail to respond, the Commission may dismiss this application for failure to prosecute..

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Harold and Debbie Meyer shall respond in writing, no later than August 20, 2010, notifying the Commission whether they wish to pursue their application. If they wish to continue, they shall state on which dates they would be available to participate in a prehearing conference, either in person or by telephone.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
