ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO LATE-FILE HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL PORTION OF STAFF REPORT AND REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO LATE-FILE AFFIDAVITS

On February 5, 2007, Aquila Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P, filed its Utility Resource Filing as required by 4 CSR 240-22. This filing is also sometimes known as an integrated resource plan, or IRP. According to Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-22.080(5) and (6), other parties would have until June 5, 2007 to respond. However, the Commission granted a motion from the Office of the Public Counsel, and extended the deadline for responses to June 19.

On June 20, Staff filed a Request for Leave to Late-File Highly Confidential Portion of Staff Report, and a Request for Leave to Late-File Affidavits. Staff explained that it was one day late with its report and affidavits due to the press of business, and that no party would be prejudiced by the one-day delay.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. No party opposed Staff's requests. The Commission takes up Staff's motions unopposed, finds them to be reasonable, and will grant them.
