On April 13, 2007, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks-MPS and Aquila Networks-L&P filed tariff sheets to continue its Fixed Bill Pilot Program. The tariffs were due to go into effect July 1, 2007, and the Commission ordered Staff to file a Recommendation no later than June 21.

On June 15, Aquila asked that the effective date of the tariff be delayed until August 1. Accordingly, on June 20, Staff asked for additional time, namely, until July 23, to file its Recommendation, which the Staff granted.

On July 19, Aquila filed another extension of its tariff sheets, making them effective September 1. Staff then requested an extension of time until August 24 to file a Recommendation or Status Report.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.
