ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed its Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) pursuant to Chapter 22 of the Commission's rules on February 5, 2008. On June 18, various parties filed comments regarding what they contend are deficiencies in AmerenUE's plan. By Commission rule, AmerenUE and the other parties were allowed until August 4 to file a joint agreement regarding correction of those alleged deficiencies. On August 4, AmerenUE filed a motion asking that the deadline for filing a joint agreement be extended to August 6. The motion represents that no party objects to the proposed extension.

Section 12 of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080 provides that the Commission may extend or reduce any of the time periods specified in the rule for good cause shown. The Commission finds that AmerenUE has shown good cause for extending the time for filing a joint agreement. The requested extension of time will be granted.
