## ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On May 22, 2014, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a Notification and issued a revised tariff sheet that will terminate its Energy Star New Homes Program as not cost-effective. That tariff carries a June 21, 2014 effective date. The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation on June 6, advising the Commission to approve the termination of the program and the implementing tariff. But Staff stated that the approval should be conditioned on Ameren Missouri filing the affidavit verifying its application that Staff believes is required by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060.

The Commission will direct Ameren Missouri to respond to Staff's recommendation by either filing the affidavit Staff says is needed, or by explaining why the filing of such an affidavit is not required.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall respond to Staff's recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff filing no later than June 13, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective when issued.
