ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO STAFF'S MOTION TO STRIKE A PORTION OF PUBLIC COUNSEL'S DIRECT TESTMONY

Issue Date: October 29, 2014 Effective Date: October 29, 2014

On October 29, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to strike a portion of the direct testimony filed by Public Counsel's witness. Staff contends the challenged testimony constitutes an untimely change request contrary to the terms of the 2012 stipulation and agreement approved in this case. By Commission rule, the other parties are allowed ten days to respond to Staff's motion, unless the Commission establishes some other date for response.¹

The procedural schedule for this case requires the parties to file rebuttal testimony by November 17. If the parties are to know what direct testimony they must rebut, the Commission will need to rule on Staff's motion no later than its agenda meeting of November 12. The ten-day rule would make responses due by Saturday, November 8. Since that is a weekend, responses would actually be due the following Monday, November 10. That would not allow the Commission sufficient time to consider any response before its November 12 agenda meeting. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for responding to Staff's motion to Wednesday, November 5.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- Any party wishing to respond to Staff's Motion to Exclude the Portion of Public Counsel Witness Geoff Marke's Direct Testimony Regarding Rebound Effects shall do so no later than November 5, 2014.
