**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO AGREEMENT TO  
INCLUDE ADDITIONAL MEASURES IN AMEREN MISSOURI'S  
TECHNICAL RESOURCE MANUAL**

On February 8, 2013, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri; the Commission's Staff; the Office of the Public Counsel; the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the Natural Resources Defense Counsel; Sierra Club; and Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri jointly filed an agreement for Ameren Missouri to include additional measures in its Technical Resources Manual, which the Commission approved on August 1, 2012 as part of the unanimous stipulation and agreement that resolved this case. The February 8 agreement was signed by all the parties that signed the previously approved stipulation and agreement except for the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers and Barnes-Jewish Hospital. Although those two parties did not sign the agreement, the agreement represents that they do not oppose it.

Along with the agreement, Ameren Missouri filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the agreement to be effective by February 13, 2013. That request for expedited consideration is also set out as part of the agreement.

It appears that all interested parties to this case either signed the agreement or do not oppose that agreement. However, before addressing the agreement at its February 13 agenda meeting, the Commission will establish a date for the filing of responses.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Agreement to Include Additional Measures in Ameren Missouri's Technical Resource Manual shall do so no later than February 12, 2013.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
