**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ACCEPT CORRECTIONS
TO AMEREN MISSOURI WITNESS RICHARD A. VOYTAS’ TESTIMONY**

On December 30, 2014, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to accept certain corrections to the direct and rebuttal testimony filed by Ameren Missouri’s witness Richard A. Voytas. The motion described the necessary corrections, and Ameren Missouri filed corrected versions of the testimony along with its motion.

In an order issued on December 31, the Commission directed that any response to Ameren Missouri’s motion be filed no later than January 2, 2015. No party has filed an objection to Ameren Missouri’s motion.

Ameren Missouri’s motion to accept its corrections to Mr. Voytas’ testimony is reasonable, and the Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri’s Motion to Accept Corrections to Ameren Missouri Witness Richard A. Voytas’ Prefiled Direct and Rebuttal Testimony is granted.
