ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Kansas City Power & Light Company filed its 2012 Integrated Resource Plan on April 9, 2012. On April 12, the Commission issued an order directing that notice of that filing be sent to potentially interested parties. That order established May 3 as the deadline for applications to intervene.

The Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG);¹ Dogwood Energy, LLC; Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC);² Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri, and the Natural Resources Defense Council; the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission (MJMEUC); and Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, filed timely applications to intervene. More than ten days have passed since those applications were filed and no party has objected to any of the applications.

The Commission finds that the interest of each of the applicants to intervene is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order

arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing each of the applicants to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant each of the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene of the Midwest Energy Consumers Group is granted.
2. The application to intervene of Dogwood Energy, LLC, is granted.
3. 3. The application to intervene of Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri, and the Natural Resources Defense Council is granted.
4. The application to intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.
5. The application to intervene of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted.
6. The application to intervene of the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission is granted.
7. The application to intervene of Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, is granted.

8. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
