On April 13, 2012¹, Nickie Hertzog filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that her electric supplier be changed from Osage Valley Electric Cooperative ("Osage Valley") to Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L"). The Commission made Osage Valley a party, and required Osage Valley to respond no later than May 16. On May 24, the Commission ordered its Staff to respond no later than July 30.

On July 30, the Staff of the Commission asked for an extension of time to file its report. Staff explains that it has been unable to contact Ms. Hertzog, and, thus, would like until August 7 to respond. Staff represents that due to its inability to contact Ms. Hertzog, it cannot state whether she objects to the motion or not. All other parties, however, do not object, according to Staff.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

 The Motion for Extension of Time filed by the Staff of the Commission is granted.
