On December 5, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Canceling Procedural Schedule and Order Canceling Hearing. That order notified that parties that Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(2) allows the Commission to dismiss a case if no action has occurred in 90 days. More than 90 days have elapsed since the Commission's December 5, 2012 order, and no party has filed any pleadings since that order.

The Commission will allow Ms. Hertzog to explain why this case should not be dismissed. If the Commission does not receive a timely response, the Commission will likely dismiss the case.

1. Nickie Hertzog may explain why her case should not be dismissed by filing a pleading with the Commission stating cause no later than March 15, 2013.
