ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE OUT OF TIME

On September 5, 2008, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, submitted proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service in its Missouri service area. On September 12, 2008, the Commission issued an order giving notice of the tariff filing and setting procedural dates, including an October 2, 2008 intervention date.

The following parties filed applications to intervene after the intervention deadline had passed: The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Unions No. 412, 1464, and 1613; the City of Kansas City, Missouri; and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. The Commission set October 27, 2008, as the deadline for any party to file a response or objection to the late-filed applications. No responses or objections have been received.

The Commission finds that the applicants have interests in this proceeding that are different from those of the general public; and that granting the interventions will serve the public interest.

Each of the applications to intervene was filed after the Commission-ordered deadline for interventions had passed. Each of the parties alleges that good cause exists

to allow its intervention because it did not receive notice of the rate filing in sufficient time to respond. The Commission finds good cause exists to grant the applications. The Unions, the City of Kansas City, and the Department of Natural Resources shall comply with the procedural orders of this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene Out of Time of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Unions No. 412, 1464, and 1613, is granted.
2. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Late Filed Application to Intervene is granted.
3. The City of Kansas City, Missouri's Application to Intervene Out of Time is granted.
4. The Data Center of the Commission shall add these parties to the service list for Case No. ER-2009-0090.
5. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
