On September 15, 2005, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed an application in which it seeks to abandon its certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide steam service to the Capitol Group of Buildings in Jefferson City, Missouri. According AmerenUE's application, it no longer provides this service and the State of Missouri has constructed its own steam plant. The Commission needs additional information before making its decision.

AmerenUE shall provide the following additional information to the Commission:

1. What happened to the assets that were being used to provide steam heat?
2. If a transfer of assets was made, in what case did the Commission approve that transfer?
3. Are there any accounts remaining on AmerenUE's books related to the steam heat assets?

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, shall file a pleading with the above information no later than March 13, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on February 10, 2006.
