ORDER EXTENDING DATE FOR AMEREN MISSOURI TO FILE ITS 2011 INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN

This case was established to consider matters leading up to the filing of Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's 2011 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which Ameren Missouri is currently required to file by February 5, 2011. On January 14, Ameren Missouri filed a motion indicating it will be unable to meet that deadline and asking the Commission to allow it until February 23 to file its IRP. Ameren Missouri asked the Commission to rule on its motion by January 28.

On January 14, the Commission issued an order directing that any party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri's request for more time do so no later than January 21. No party has filed such a response.

Ameren Missouri indicates it needs extra time to complete all documentation and satisfy all filing requirements relating to its IRP. That request is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant Ameren Missouri's request for an extension of time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's Request to Modify Integrated Resource Plan Filing Date is granted.

- 2. Ameren Missouri shall file its next Integrated Resource Plan no later than February 23, 2011.
- 3. Ameren Missouri shall file its next Integrated Resource Plan in a new case file rather than in this case.
 - 4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
