On April 28, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed a motion requesting the Commission grant it a variance from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100.4(K), to allow an additional month for inspections of customers’ solar electric systems by certain jurisdictional authorities. On May 28, 2014, Ameren Missouri filed a *Notice of Dismissal*, stating it has withdrawn Tariff Tracking No. JE-2014-0429 and was also withdrawing the associated request for a variance.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a party may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. Since no prepared testimony or oral evidence was offered, the Commission will take notice of the dismissal.

The Commission will cancel the pre-hearing conference scheduled for May 29, 2014 and close this file.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The pre-hearing conference scheduled for Thursday, May 29, 2014, is canceled.

2. This file shall be closed on May 29, 2014.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
