## ORDER SETTING DATE FOR VARIANCE COMMITTEE REPORT AND FOR RESPONSES

Issue Date: February 10, 2021 Effective Date: February 10, 2021

On January 29, 2021, the variance committee established by the Commission filed a *Status Report* indicating that it expects to file its report no later than March 1, 2021, regarding the application filed by Grove Lofts STL, LLC and Checkmate Design, LLC, requesting a variance from the requirement to individually meter a residential building. Additionally, the Commission's rule gives the applicants ten days from the date of the variance committee's report of its "findings to accede or request a formal hearing before the [C]ommission." Therefore, the Commission will set the date for the variance committee's report and any responses or requests for hearing.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than March 1, 2021, the variance committee established pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.050(5) shall file either a recommendation and report of its findings regarding the application for variance or a status report indicating when it expects to file its recommendation and findings.

- 2. Any request for a formal hearing before the Commission or other response to the variance committee's report of its findings must be filed no later than ten days after the filing of the variance committee's report.
