

**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On April 22, 2002, Citizens Electric Corporation filed a Status Report. The Report indicates that the "second and final draw down was in the amount of \$4,005.000" [sic]. However, the Interim Status Report, filed April 9, 2002, and the Status Report filed on February 28, 2002, suggest that the correct amount is \$4,005,000, not \$4,005.00. The Commission will direct the company to file a pleading clarifying the amount of the second and final draw-down.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That no later than May 16, 2002, Citizens Electric Corporation shall file a pleading clarifying the correct amount of the second and final draw-down.
2. That this order shall become effective on May 12, 2002.
