## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) on September 27, 2020. On October 5, the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) applied to intervene. More than ten days have passed and no party has responded to that application. <sup>2</sup>

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing NRDC to participate in the review of Ameren Missouri's IRP will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant NRDC's application to intervene.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Application to Intervene of Natural Resource Defense Council is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
