On July 27, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission opened this case directing the Staff of the Commission to begin a formal investigation of Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE and any other regulated utilities whose activities have an impact on storm restoration efforts concerning the effectiveness of its storm preparation and restoration efforts in Eastern Missouri.

Staff filed a report on August 25, 2007, local public hearings were held in October 2007 and an On-the-Record presentation was held on December 27, 2007.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's report, along with the official file, and finds that this case has accomplished its goal of obtaining information regarding AmerenUE's Storm Preparation and Restoration Efforts in Eastern Missouri. In addition, AmerenUE is currently being investigated, Case No. ES-2007-0474, regarding the Taum Sauk Incident. Therefore, this case shall be closed.
