ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On January 29, 2007, Cynthia Evans applied for a change of electrical supplier from The Empire District Electric Company to Ozark Electric Cooperative, Inc. Ms. Evans' petition was deficient, and the Commission notified Ms. Evans of those deficiencies on January 30, stating that it would not act on the application until she corrected the enumerated deficiencies.

On April 24, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Show Cause. Staff pointed out that Ms. Evans has failed to correct her petition, and asked the Commission to order Ms. Evans to show cause why her petition should not be dismissed.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it. If Ms. Evans fails to respond to the Commission's order, the Commission may dismiss her petition.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Cynthia Evans shall show cause why her petition should not be dismissed by responding to Staff's motion no later than May 9, 2007.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 25, 2007.
