ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEFS

On May 16, 2008, Midwest ISO filed a motion requesting a ten-day extension of time to file post-hearing briefs. Those briefs are currently due by May 27, and Midwest ISO asks the Commission to extend that filing date to June 6. Midwest ISO's motion represents that Staff, Public Counsel, the City of Independence, Dogwood Energy, Southwest Power Pool, KCPL, and AmerenUE do not object to the proposed extension. However, the motion also states Aquila has indicated opposition to the extension.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because the Commission will need to rule on the motion for extension promptly, it will shorten the time allowed for filing a response to Midwest ISO's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Midwest ISO's Motion for Extension of Time shall do so no later than May 20, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on May 16, 2008.
