ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On June 22, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a notice of change in its preferred resource plan pursuant to the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning rule - 20 CSR 4240-22.080(12). On July 15, the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) applied to intervene. More than ten days have passed and no one has responded to NRDC's motion to intervene.¹

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing NRDC to participate will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the motion to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. NRDC's application to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
