On September 28, 2005, The Empire Electric District Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission an application for authority to transfer functional control of certain transmission assets to the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. On October 18, 2005, Aquila, Inc. filed an application to intervene.

In its discussions during the Agenda Meeting on October 25, 2005, the Commission expressed a desire to have input regarding Aquila's request to intervene from the Staff of the Commission; particularly, Dr. Michael Proctor who the Commission considers to have extensive knowledge with regard to power pools.

The Commission will therefore require Staff to file a pleading indicating whether it opposes or supports Aquila's request to intervene. Moreover, if Staff supports Aquila's request, the Commission will require that Staff explain how Aquila's participation in this matter, as a party, will serve the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file no later than November 7, 2005, a pleading as described in the body of this order.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 26, 2005.
