On December 26, 2006, the Commission set a date for the parties in these matters to file pleadings addressing the threshold question on the applicability of the prior state action exemption to the adoption of the Fuel Sources Standard and the Fossil Fuel Generation Efficiency Standard. These pleadings were directed to be filed no later than February 9, 2007.

A decision by the Commission that prior state action has satisfied EPAct's current requirements would terminate these proceedings, while an opposite decision would require the Commission to initiate rulemaking for the purposes of adopting the standards. The Commission has reviewed the pleadings filed by all of the parties in these matters, finds that these standards have issues in common, and has questions for the parties. Accordingly, the Commission will schedule an on-the-record session to allow the parties' representatives and experts to address the Commission's questions.
