ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND
RESETTING STIPULATION HEARING

On March 9, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company requested that the Stipulation Hearing set for March 14, 2007, be continued and rescheduled for April 26, 2007. KCPL stated that this would allow it sufficient time to prepare with regard to the list of topics that Commissioners Gaw and Clayton indicated would be the subject of the hearing. KCPL stated that none of the other parties to the case object to the continuance.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds it to be reasonable. Therefore, the Commission shall grant the continuance with the exception of the hearing date requested. The Commission already has two hearings scheduled for April 26th, and cannot accommodate another April 26th hearing. Therefore, the Commission reschedules the hearing as set out below.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. With the exception of the date for the hearing, Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion for Continuance of the On-the-Record Presentation of the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.

2. The stipulation hearing originally scheduled for March 14, 2007, shall be rescheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. on April 4, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on March 13, 2007.
