## ORDER CLARIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND EXTENDING DEADLINE

Issue Date: July 24, 2020

On July 9, 2020,<sup>1</sup> the Commission issued its order requiring the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 24 and advising the case will be tried online because of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic. On July 24, the Commission Staff asked for clarification, noting the July 9 order set deadlines for filing prefiled testimony although the parties had not suggested them nor had previous procedural orders issued in this case required them. Staff asked whether the Commission was requiring prefiled testimony. Staff also asked the July 24 deadline be extended two weeks. The Commission surmised with the July 9 order that because of the COVID 19 pandemic, the parties might wish to pre-file testimony, and, accordingly, set deadlines. 1. The Commission Staff's request to extend the deadline for filing a proposed procedural schedule is sustained.

The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August
8, 2020.

3. While the Commission will not require prefiled testimony in this case, the parties shall be permitted to file same, and the proposed order shall suggest deadlines for any which the parties may choose to file.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
