**ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES**

On January 21, 2021, the Regulatory Judge held a discovery conference with counsel for Complainants, Respondents, and The Commission's Staff to address a discovery dispute. The participants were unable to resolve the dispute and it was determined that Complainants had satisfied the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8), sufficient to file a motion to compel discovery for the Commission's consideration. Complainants filed their motion to compel on January 25, 2021.

Allowing ten days for responses to the motion will impact the procedural schedule issued on January 20, 2021. So, as discussed at the discovery conference, Respondent will be allowed three business days to respond to Complainants' motion. Therefore, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13), the time for responses to Complainants' motion will be shortened.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any responses to *Complainants' Motion to Compel Answers to Data Requests* shall be filed no later than January 29, 2021.
2. This order is effective when issued.
