**ORDER PROVIDING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION DEADLINE,  
AND DIRECTING RESPONSE**

On August 27, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed a Joint Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission, requesting that the Commission grant it variances from certain requirements of the Commission’s net metering rule, 4 CSR 240-20.065. KCP&L and GMO ask the Commission to grant a variance to allow them to remove the “solar rebate application” information from their respective Net Metering Tariffs.

As the Commission’s decision to grant or deny the requested variances may affect a large portion of KCP&L and GMO’s customers, the Commission will provide notice to other potential interested parties and the public, and will establish an intervention deadline. In addition, the Commission will establish a date for its Staff and other interested parties to offer recommendations regarding KCP&L and GMO’s request for variances.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties to KCP&L and GMO’s current rate cases, ER-2018-0146 and ER-2018-0145, respectively.

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving KCP&L and GMO's service areas and to the members of the General Assembly representing KCP&L and GMO's service areas.

3. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than September 17, 2018.

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation on the application and tariff sheets no later than September 24, 2018.

5. Any other party wishing to respond to KCP&L and GMO's Joint Application for Variance shall do so no later than September 24, 2018.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
