**ORDER SHORTENING TIME TO OBJECT TO  
STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT**

On October 7, 2020, of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and the Commission's Staff filed a Stipulation and Agreement. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.115(2) provides that parties have seven days to object to a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement. The Stipulation and Agreement represents that the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), while not a signatory to the Stipulation and Agreement, did not object to the Agreement. The seven days for parties to respond to the Stipulation and Agreement extends beyond the next Commission Agenda. Accordingly, the time for objections to the Stipulation and Agreement will be shortened by one day.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any objections to the Stipulation and Agreement shall be filed no later than October 13, 2020.
2. This order is effective when issued.
