On October 9, 2013, the Commission issued a Report and Order. Also on October 9, after the Report and Order was issued, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Correction Nunc Pro Tunc.

Staff points out that the Report and Order contained a Conclusion of Law referring to the General Counsel¹. In fact, Staff states, the Conclusion of Law should have referred to Staff Counsel instead of General Counsel.²

The Commission recently reorganized its personnel, and the Commission's intent was to refer to Staff Counsel in the referenced Conclusion of Law, not General Counsel.

Thus, the Commission issues this order *nunc pro tunc* to reflect the Commission's intent.
