**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S
REQUEST FOR ORDER**

On October 16, 2015, Public Counsel filed a pleading asking the Commission to issue an order directing Kansas City Power & Light Company to either stop MEEIA program activity once it reaches 120 percent of its approved program budget, or to require KCP&L to apply for approval to modify its MEEIA program budget to reflect the increased spending. The Commission will establish a time for KCP&L and the other parties to respond to Public Counsel's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Request for Order shall do so no later than October 26, 2015.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
