**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO KCP&L'S APPLICATION
FOR APPROVAL OF MODIFICATIONS OF DEMAND-SIDE PROGRAMS**

On November 13, 2015, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed a pleading asking the Commission to modify its MEEIA program budget to reflect spending that has exceeded its budget by more than 120 percent. By rule, the Commission must act on that request for modification within 30 days of its filing. The Commission will establish a time for the parties to respond to KCP&L's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Kansas City Power & Light's Application for Approval of Modifications of Demand-Side Programs shall do so no later than November 23, 2015.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
