STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its recommendation respectfully states:

1. On April 1, 2014, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire" or "Company") filed direct testimony and supporting schedules supporting its ninth Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") true-up filing to identify the amount of over- or underrecovery of the FAC for a previous 6-month recovery period, as required by Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.161(8) and 4 CSR 240-20.090(5).

2. Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to examine and analyze the information Empire has submitted and to submit a recommendation to the Commission not later than 30 days after Empire made its filing—in this case, no later than May 1, 2014.

3. As explained in Staff's *Memorandum*, attached hereto as Appendix A and incorporated herein by reference, Staff recommends the Commission approve Empire's ninth true-up filing for Recovery Period 9, during which Empire over-recovered \$231,336 from its customers.

4. Staff reviewed and analyzed the direct testimony and supporting schedules of Empire witness Todd W. Tarter. Staff found that Empire's calculations for the true-up amount, including interest, for Recovery Period 9 (billing months of June

2013 through November 2013) are correct. The over-recovered amount, including accumulated interest, is included in Empire's calculation of its proposed current period Fuel Adjustment Rate ("FAR") amount included in the Company's Accumulation Period 11 (AP11) adjustment filing, also filed on April 1, 2014, in File No. ER-2014-0264.¹

5. Staff has verified that Empire has filed its 2013 annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Empire is current on its submission of its Surveillance Monitoring reports as required in 4 CSR 240-20.090(10), and its monthly reports as required by 4 CSR 240-3.161(5). With the exception of Empire's proposed current period FAR contained in its semi-annual FAC filing in File No. ER-2014-0264, Staff is not aware of any other matter before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing.

WHEREFORE, Staff submits its analysis and recommends that the Commission approve Empire's ninth true-up filing for Recovery Period 9 under the provisions of 4 CSR 240-3.161(8) and 4 CSR 240-20.090(5).

¹ In the Matter of The Empire District Electric Company for Authority to Implement Rate Adjustments Related to The Company's Fuel And Purchased Power Adjustment (FAC) Required in 4 CSR 240-20.090(4), filed on April 1, 2014. In this case, Empire requested Commission approval of a tariff sheet to adjust rates for the FAC includable costs experienced during the six-month accumulation period (AP11).

On April 1, 2014, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire" or "Company") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the form of direct testimony and supporting schedules by Todd W. Tarter, its ninth true-up filing under the provisions in 4 CSR 240-3.161(8) and 4 CSR 240-20.090(5).

The true-up amount of \$(231,336) identified in this filing is the result of an overcollection during Recovery Period 9 ("RP9") that includes the billing months of June 2013 through November 2013. RP9 is the recovery period for and following Accumulation Period 9 ("AP9") that includes the period of September 1, 2012 through February 28, 2013.

The over-collection of \$231,336 true-up amount for RP9 is included in the calculation of the Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment ("FPA") amount included in the Company's Accumulation Period 11 ("AP11") adjustment filing, also filed on April 1, 2014, in File No. ER-2014-0264, in compliance with Empire's FAC.¹

The Commission's Staff ("Staff") examined the direct testimony of Todd W. Tarter, the supporting schedules Empire provided with its application in this case, and the monthly information Empire has submitted to the Commission. Staff also reviewed Empire's monthly interest calculations; Staff agrees with them.

¹ The Empire District Electric Company's P.S.C. Mo. No. 5, Section 4, 6th Revised Sheet No. 17c tariff sheet: "<u>TRUE-UP OF FPA</u>: In conjunction with an adjustment to its FAR, the Company will make a trueup filing with and adjustment to its FAC on the first Filing Date that occurs after completion of each Recovery Period. The true-up adjustment shall be the difference between the FPA revenues billed and the FPA revenues authorized for collection during the true-up recovery period, i.e. the true-up adjustment. Any true-up adjustments or refunds shall be reflected in item T above and shall include interest calculated as provided for in item I above."

Based on its examination and analysis of information Empire filed and submitted in this case, Staff recommends the Commission approve Empire's RP9 true-up filing for the billing months June 2013 through November 2013 during which Empire over-collected \$231,336 from its customers for inclusion in the calculation of the FPA amount included in the Company's AP11 adjustment filing in File No. ER-2014-0264.

Staff has verified that Empire has filed its 2013 annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Empire is current on its submission of its Surveillance Monitoring reports as required in 4 CSR 240-20.090(10) and its monthly reports as required by 4 CSR 240-3.161(5).
