ORDER REGARDING CUSTOMER NOTICE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the City of Columbia, Missouri and Boone Electric Cooperative to serve Staff with information in consideration of Staff's suggestions,¹ to which the Commission received no response within the time set by regulation,² and directing the parties to file a draft notice.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than August 14, 2014, the City of Columbia, Missouri ("city"), and Boone Electric Cooperative (coop") (together, "applicants") shall serve Staff with a list including any of the following that is the subject of the application:

- a. Any current coop member as to whom the application proposes to change service from the coop to the city;
- b. The owner of record of any structure as to which the application proposes to change service from the coop to the city;
- c. A current mailing address for any person listed in subparagraph a or b of this paragraph.

2. No later than August 21, 2014, applicants and Staff shall file jointly or separately:

- a. A draft notice of this action stating:
 - i. That the applicants are seeking the Commission's approval to change the electric service to the structures from the coop to the city; and
 - ii. How to participate and be heard in the action.
 - b. A pleading accompanying the draft notice stating:
 - i. Whether any party objects to the draft notice; and
 - ii. A suggested deadline for filing an application for intervention.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
