On April 2, 2015<sup>1</sup>, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed a Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule and For Expedited Treatment. In the motion, Ameren Missouri explains that the current procedural schedule will no longer work.

Because surrebuttal testimony is currently due on April 13, Ameren Missouri asks for expedited treatment. In particular, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to set a deadline of April 7 for objections to its Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule.

The Commission finds Ameren Missouri’s request for an April 7 deadline to respond reasonable. Thus, the Commission will grant the request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any objections to the Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule shall be filed no later than April 7, 2015.
