## ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO SUBMIT EITHER A STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT OR A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, has applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. On May 16, 2011, Ameren Missouri filed a status report indicating that it continues to discuss its application with the other parties. Ameren Missouri reports it may be able to resolve the application through the filing of a stipulation and agreement and asks that it be allowed until June 30 to file either a stipulation and agreement or a proposed procedural schedule. Ameren Missouri represents that the other parties do not object to its request for more time.

Ameren Missouri's request is reasonable and the Commission will direct the parties to file either a stipulation and agreement resolving this case or a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 30.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than June 30, 2011, the parties shall file either a stipulation and agreement resolving this case or a proposed procedural schedule to resolve this case through a contested hearing.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
